Instructions for Completing Application: Electrical work shall not begin until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with State Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call 24 hrs. in advance and provide type of inspection, job location, permit #, your name and phone number.

Expiration of Permit: Permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work has not begun within 6 mos. after issuance or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 6 mos. after the work has begun. **A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within 6 mos. of the issued date or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.**

Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except: 1) When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 sq. ft. in area. 2) Work is completed by a government subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.

***Homeowner Affidavit:** I hereby certify the electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed **by myself in my own home** in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the State Electrical Code and **shall not be enclosed covered up**, or put into operation until it has been **inspected** and **approved** by the County Inspector. I will cooperate with the County Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for all necessary inspections.
