12. Mining - Only includes removal of clay, gravel, sand, peat & topsoil

Annual Operating Fee	\$100.00
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13. Renew Permit Fees

1 Year renewal	½ of original fee
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At the time of application, the total fee will be required before the actual plan review will commence. Should the project be cancelled prior to a review and site inspection by this office, the fee will be refunded, less a \$25 processing fee, upon written request to the Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Agency.

Non-residential projects MAY require engineered site plans with runoff calculations. If the enforcing agent feels that it is necessary to have a professional engineer review the plans, all review costs will be paid for by the developer. A \$500 deposit will be required before the permit is issued and any unused portion of this deposit will be returned when project is finalized.
